The research evaluates the effects of a single HydraScalp treatment on key measures of the scalp microenvironment, as well as changes in skin hydration and overall skin quality following a series of monthly Hydrafacial treatments across Fitzpatrick skin types I-VI.

Clinical Evaluation of the Benefits of Monthly Hydrafacial Treatments Across All Fitzpatrick Skin Types

This Phase IV open-label study evaluated changes in skin hydration and overall skin quality following a series of monthly Deluxe Hydrafacial treatments with the Hydrafacial ReGen GF™ Booster among participants with Fitzpatrick skin types I-VI.

Key Findings:

- 100% of subjects showed a Global Aesthetic Improvement as assessed by the expert investigator
- Statistically significant improvements were observed across multiple measures of skin hydration and skin quality, including skin roughness, and the appearance of wrinkles, elasticity, and pore size.
